The Mississippi Commission on College Accreditation (MCCA or Commission) at its May 25, 2022, meeting took the following action regarding Upper Iowa University:

The Commission granted Upper Iowa University provisional approval for 2022-2023 to offer on-base courses that represent less than 50% of credits required for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Bachelor of Science in Accounting, Master of Business Administration (General), and Master of Business Administration (Accounting) at the Naval Air Station Meridian, 255 Rosenbaum Avenue.

Upper Iowa University is to submit a progress report by February 1, 2023, that includes at minimum:

- o Fully executed facility use agreement/MOA with Naval Air Station Meridian
- o Audited financial report for most recent fiscal year
- o Clarification regarding compliance with faculty requirements.

Upper Iowa University must submit progress reports, other reports as requested by the Commission, and timely notifications and requests for approval prior to implementing changes in approved locations and activities, and other relevant changes. The institution must submit to the Commission copies of reports, substantive change requests, and correspondence submitted by the institution to accrediting agencies as well as copies of notices and correspondence received from accrediting agencies and the U.S. Department of Education concerning formal action.
